


WARRIOR STELAE, VIIIth-VIIth cent.BC



Warrior-*stelae*: these slabs are typical of the archaeology of southwestern Spain. They represent, schematically, a human figure, a sword, a shield, a two-horse chariot and other luxury items. They are generally interpreted as representations of great chieftains, though their true meaning is as yet undefined. This museum presents the most comprehensive collection of its kind
